

WHAT AFFECTS THE PRICE OF PHARMACEUTICAL TRANSPORT?



FUEL

The basic component of the price of road transport. Its amount is determined by world fuel prices, but the distance and route have a major impact on the price.



ROAD TOLLS

Goods are delivered to different places. This is often combined with additional tolls for motorways, bridges, tunnels or ferry crossings.



QUALITY AND SAFETY CERTIFICATES

In order to guarantee the highest quality and safety, the carrier certifies its services (ISO9001:2015, GDP, TAPA TSR 1), incurring additional costs.



QUALIFYING VEHICLES

In order for a vehicle to become qualified, it undergoes a whole series of costly tests and certification (including calibration, GPS systems, security locks, mappings).



STAFF TRAINING

Regular training of employees ensures that they are able to identify potential hazards and risks related to the transport of medicines and manage them appropriately.
